

# Niagara 4.10 - New Edge Licensing Scheme

### **Frequently Asked Questions**

Niagara 4.10 introduces a New Edge Licensing Scheme for Supervisor Niagara Network connections which allows you to connect **10 Niagara Edge devices** to a Supervisor for the same price as a standard Niagara station connection.

### Q: Which Edge Devices Qualify?

A: This licensing scheme applies to Niagara Edge 10 and OEM Edge devices 'powered by Niagara framework' with a license for 150 points capacity or less.

A combination of Niagara Edge 10 and OEM Niagara Edge devices can be used together with each counting as a single Niagara Network Edge connection.

#### Q: Does this apply to JACE?

A: No, this is not applicable for JACE platforms regardless of point capacity.

#### Q: What Do I Need to Do?

A: Simply follow the steps below and enjoy connecting **10 times more Niagara Edge devices** to your Supervisor for the same price.

- 1. Upgrade your Supervisor Station to Niagara 4.10
- 2. Download an updated license for your Niagara Edge device

Discover your Niagara Edge devices and Add to your Supervisor Niagara Network.

#### Q: Can you Provide an Example of How This Works?

A: Niagara Edge 10 or OEM devices 'powered by Niagara framework' with a 150 points or less based capacity license now count as a 1/10 of a standard Niagara Network connection.

Let's review a few examples to provide some clarification:

- For a Supervisor with 1 Niagara Network connection, you can now connect...
  - o 1 JACE OR
  - o Up to 10 Niagara Edge devices

- For a Supervisor with 2 Niagara Network connections, you can now connect...
  - Up to 20 Niagara Edge devices OR
  - Up to 10 Niagara Edge devices AND 1 JACE or Supervisor

Note: 1 JACE and 1 Niagara Edge device requires 2 connections, but so does 1 JACE and 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9 or 10 Niagara Edge devices!

- For a Supervisor with 3 Niagara Network connections, you can now connect...
  - Up to 30 Niagara Edge devices OR
  - Up to 20 Niagara Edge devices AND 1 JACE or Supervisor
  - Up to 10 Niagara Edge devices AND 1 JACE AND 1 Supervisor
    OR
  - Up to 10 Niagara Edge devices AND 2 JACEs or Supervisors
- For a Supervisor with 10 Niagara Network connections, you can now connect...
  - Up to 100 Niagara Edge devices OR
  - Up to 90 Niagara Edge devices AND 1 JACE or Supervisor
  - Up to 80 Niagara Edge devices AND 2 JACEs or Supervisors
    OR
  - Up to 80 Niagara Edge devices AND 1 JACE AND 1 Supervisor OR
  - Up to 70 Niagara Edge devices AND 3 JACEs or Supervisors OR
  - Up to 70 Niagara Edge devices AND 2 JACEs AND 1 Supervisor
    OR
  - Up to 70 Niagara Edge devices AND 1 JACE AND 2 Supervisors etc.

### Q: Can I Use this New Licensing Schema with Preexisting Edge Devices in my Supervisor Niagara Network?

A: Yes. For any customers with pre-existing Edge devices in a Supervisor's Niagara Network, there are two (2) potential options you can employ to start using the new Edge licensing schema without having to rediscover the station:

#### 1. Option-1

- a. Add a new "Niagara Edge Station" to your Supervisor's Niagara Network and configure the network parameters accordingly (leave disabled until "Step E")
- b. Via the Niagara Network, access the points folder in the pre-existing Edge device and select all items therein. Perform the same step for all imported/exported histories and schedules under the Niagara Network
- c. Execute the Cut command for the aforementioned items selected in the previous step



- e. Paste into the points folder of the new "Niagara Edge Station" added in the step above. Perform the same step for all imported/exported histories and schedules and paste accordingly under the Niagara Network
- f. Configure the Alarm Class for the new Edge Device under the Supervisor Niagara Network to use the Alarm Class utilized by the original Edge device
- g. Disable the original Edge device
- h. Enable the recently added Niagara Edge Station
- i. Ensure the new Edge Station is an allowed host under the Supervisor Certificate Manager
- j. Delete the original Edge device
- 2. Option-2 (For Advanced Users)
  - a. Open a Platform connection and access the Station Copier
  - b. Copy the Supervisor station to your local host
  - c. Via the User Home/Stations folder, access the station bog file copied in the step above and open the text editor view of the station XML
  - d. While in the text editor, locate the pre-existing Edge device in the Supervisor Niagara Network and change the station type from "nd:NiagaraStation" to "nd:NiagaraEdgeLiteStation"
  - e. Save the bog file
  - f. Open a Platform connection and access the Station Copier
  - g. Copy the Supervisor station edited in the step above on your local host and copy to the Supervisor host

## Q: I have an OEM Niagara Edge device with less than 150 points that allows capacity upgrades. What happens if I add an upgrade option to exceed 150 points?

A: The Niagara Edge device license has a platform feature with an attribute to indicate it is an Edge platform. If upgrading to over 150 points, then this attribute will be reset.

The Niagara network connection to a device will only count as an Edge connection if the license indicates it is an Edge platform.

If the capacity is over 150 points, then it will revert to a standard Niagara network connection regardless of station type. It will only connect if your Supervisor license has adequate Niagara capacity
